Ames Police Charge Homicide Suspect

On August 19, 2021, at 6:10 p.m., the Ames Police Department conducted a welfare check at an apartment at 5308 Mortensen Road. Officers entered the apartment and found a deceased female inside. Based on the initial investigation, it appeared the deceased died as a result of a homicide. The deceased was transported to the State Medical Examiner's Office for an autopsy. The name of the deceased is being withheld pending notification of family.

Follow-up investigation by the Ames Police Department and the Iowa Division of Criminal Investigation identified the suspect as Oscar Chavez, age 26, of Ames. Chavez was stopped by Sac County Sheriff's deputies near Auburn, Iowa at 11:55 p.m. on August 19, 2021. Chavez was taken into custody and charged with Murder in the 1st Degree, a class "A" felony. Chavez is being held in the Story County Jail.

The Ames Police Department and Iowa Division of Criminal Investigation continue to investigate this incident. The Sac County Sheriff's Office also assisted in the investigation.
