

VACATION

All regular full-time Firefighters receive vacation time each year and will be earned as follows

- The first seven years firefighters will earn 9 hours and 20 minutes each month. This is total annual earnings of 112 hours. The total allowable accumulation is 168 hours.
- Th 8th through the 14th year of service firefighters will earn 14 hours each month. This is total annual earnings of 168 hours. The total allowable accumulation is 252 hours.
- After completing 14 years of service firefighters will earn 18 hours and 40 minutes each month. This is total annual earnings of 224 hours. The total allowable accumulation is 336 hours.
- After completing 23 years of service firefighters will earn 23 hours and 20 minutes each month. This is total annual earnings of 280 hours. The total allowable accumulation is 420 hours.
