#### **Narrative Description**

Located on the south side of Park Way, facing northeast, this is a one-story Craftsman cottage with side gable, hip-roofed front wing, and one and a half-story garage addition. Located on the north side of Park Way, facing south, this is a one-story Craftsman cottage with a hip roof. Constructed in 1928 according to Ames City Assessor data. 


