Therefore, prior to any construction activity including but not limited to grading, stockpiling, site clearing where no impervious areas is being created a grading permit shall be obtained. Sites shall comply with floodplain regulation and obtain a floodplain permit as required.

- This permit must be approved prior to grading or fill at the site location.
- Compaction reduction must be achieved by deep tilling a minimum of six inches during final stabilization for both seeding and sodding
- Sediment perimeter controls must be in place prior to land disturbing activities unless clearing and grubbing required to access control location.
- This site must stay in compliance with Iowa NPDES General Permit #2 and the City of Ames 5A and 5B Ames City Code.
- The owner shall be responsible for the removal of all soil and debris spilled or washed onto adjoining properties or city right-of-way during construction and repair any damage caused by such soil and debris.
- Iowa Drainage law shall be followed.
- This permit may be revoked due to inadequate erosion control, safety concerns, track out, spillages, or regard for drainage.
