- (b) contracts in which a City officer has an interest solely by reason of employment if the contract is for professional services not customarily awarded by competitive bid and if the remuneration of employment will not be directly affected as a result

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of the contract and the duties of employment do not directly involve the procurement or preparation of any part of the contract.

- (c) a contract in which a City officer has an interest if the contract was made before the time the officer was elected or appointed, but the contract may not be renewed.
- (d) a contract with a corporation in which a City officer has an interest by reason of stockholdings when less than five percent of the outstanding stock of the corporation is owned or controlled directly or indirectly by the officer, or the spouse, or immediate family of such officer.
- (e) contract not otherwise permitted by this section, for the purchase of goods or services by the City, which benefit a City officer, if the purchases benefiting that officer do not exceed a cumulative total price of \$1,500 in a fiscal year.
